By filling in the above, I understand that if I have travelled to China between 22 January 2020 and the current date, I should monitor my health closely for 2 weeks upon entering Singapore. I should seek medical attention promptly if feeling unwell, and also inform the doctor of travel history.

In accordance with the announcement by MOH, New visitors who have travelled to Hubei in the last 14 days, as well as holders of Chinese passports issued in Hubei will not be allowed entry into Singapore, or transit through Singapore. Issuance of new visas as well as previously issued short-term and multiple-visit visas, and visa-free transit facilities, for holders of Chinese passports issued in Hubei, have also been suspended. For travellers who have arrived in Singapore from other parts of China, they should monitor their health closely for 2 weeks upon entering Singapore. They should seek medical attention promptly if they feel unwell, and also inform their doctor of their travel history. If they have a fever or respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, runny nose), they should wear a mask and call the clinic ahead of the visit.
